Key Responsibilities

1. Project Implementation Coordination

For selected projects:

- Act as project manager, leading on work planning, budgeting and risk management, liaising with Tropical Health operations and finance teams to ensure smooth coordination across the organisation
- Be Tropical Health's focal point with clients/donors, on all or some aspects of the project, including but not limited to leading on providing regular activities update to clients/funders and participating in meetings, as agreed
- Coordinate and manage the performance of project teams and partners, remotely and undertaking field-level checks, as required; this includes line management responsibilities for selected staff in project locations.
- Work closely with teams in country to collate data and reports from project activities across multiple partners, as need be
- Provide first level quality assurance to project outputs, ensuring Tropical Health, its consultants and partners deliver to the technical standards expected by the client
- Support drafting and/or finalisation of deliverables to be developed by Tropical Health core team

2. Technical Consultancy

- Deliver technical consultancy in line with individual consultancy terms of reference developed. Specific roles would be determined on case-by-case basis ranging from
 - o being a thematic expert on a team
 - o leading a team of experts and coordinating overall assignment and deliverables
 - o being a sole technical consultant on a piece of work.
- Areas of technical contributions would include but are not limited to:

 - Lead on quantitative and/or qualitative data collection and/or analysis, with guidance from Technical Director
 - Draft results reports for submission to the donor/client

 - o Conduct document reviews and literature reviews as needed
 - Lead or contribute to journal publications as needed

- Lead the technical response for selected pre-qualification and expression of interest processes, project proposals and funding requests.
